JASON MARKS, Deputy Missoula County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 16th day of May, 2013, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: VEHICULAR HOMICIDE WHILE UNDER INFLUENCE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-106, punishable by 30 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: NEGLIGENT VEHICULAR ASSAULT - RESULTING IN SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-205(1)[2], punishable by 10 years MSP and/or \$10,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 16th day of May, 2013, the above-named Defendant negligently caused the death of Roberta Demmert while the Defendant was operating a vehicle in violation of 61-8-401 or 61-8-406.

## AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

JASON MARKS, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County,
Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

SS

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of TOM GEORGE VINEYARD for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2013, at approximately 1:30 a.m., Shanen Cavalier called 911 to report that there had been a crash in front of his residence on the 600 block of North 5<sup>th</sup> St. West in Missoula. He

subsequently told officers that he heard the crash and looked outside to see a pick-up truck on its side in the front yard and two women lying on the sidewalk.

Officer's arrived and found Roberta and Pamela Demmert lying on the sidewalk. Roberta was unresponsive. Pamela was obviously in considerable pain but was conscious and able to speak. She told officers that she and Roberta, her sister, had been walking to get cigarettes. Both women were transported to the hospital. Pamela was hospitalized with serious injuries including a broken leg. Roberta was pronounced dead at the hospital.

Officers located a man in the cab of the Ford Ranger pick-up. After determining he was uninjured they assisted him out of the pick-up. He was identified by his Montana driver's license as Tom Vineyard. Vineyard admitted that he was the driver of the pick-up. He stated that he been drinking downtown and was driving home. He stated that he had consumed two pitchers of beer while downtown. Vineyard repeatedly asked officers to arrest him and stated that he was at fault and wanted to take responsibility for his actions. He provided a breath sample that registered a .239 BAC.
